## NAPLAN 2018 Summary.

This week parents of students in Grades 3 and 5 will have received their NAPLAN test results. Though we are always wary of seeing NAPLAN a complete overview of student learning, it does represent a partial snapshot of information about students' performance in the five areas tested. We can gather some useful evidence about how students are performing academically at Coburg West from these results.

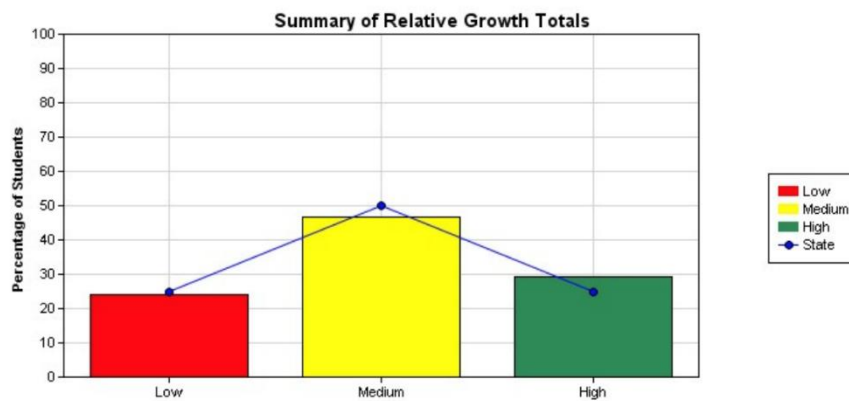
Some highlights I'd like to share with our community are:

- Grade 3 students performed well above State averages in all areas – Reading, Writing, Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation and Numeracy.
- In Grade 3 Numeracy, our students were 21 points above the state average in our scaled score for Numeracy (our 2nd Highest score in 5 years)

*This reflects the school wide approach to problem solving and our continual dedication to high student learning growth by addressing individual needs in all our classes.*

- In Grade 5 we also performed well above State averages for all areas and I was very proud to note our highest results for 5 years in Grammar and Punctuation (35 points above State average), Reading (39 points above State and our best result in many years) and Numeracy (19 points above State level and also our highest score in the past 5 years.)

This graph highlights the growth rate in Reading of our existing Grade 5 cohort from their Grade 3 results in 2016. It is pleasing to note that they are above the expected level of high growth.

As a staff we will examine the item analysis report further to see which specific areas the school performed well in and which areas students found consistently challenging. This will be used to inform planning for future cohorts.






# **The C.W.P.S Pizzeria**

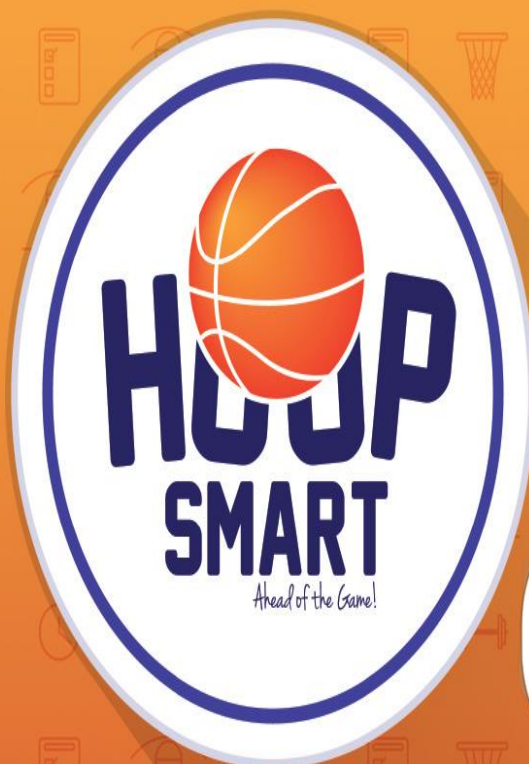

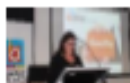
